How many of you were aware that the average worship attendance in the Western PA UM Churches is 25-30 people? And in all Christian denominations nationwide since 2023 the average worship attendance is 55-60. Wade and I learned this in a podcast from Rainer's Church Answers and was shared again at the Pittsburgh Allbright Deering Lecture series by Lovett Weems.

Some of our churches in the parish are close to that number while others surpass that number so overall we have average size congregations now. Yes, there are still those mega churches out there but more and more our size is the new norm.

Here are a few great characteristics of smaller/average size churches: 1) We are not to be embarrassed by our size but take advantage of it by kindling a family spirit – this helps the community foster such a spirit as well, 2) Have fun – enjoy each other's company and share laughs around the table,

3) Commitment to mission in small churches – trying to address critical needs within their communities, 4) having a distinctive niche – churches this small can't be everything to all but can find their niche and expand on it, 5) deepen the effectiveness of laity – without the laity, where would the church and community be, 6) deploy resources wisely – no one is wealthy but they use their resources the best they can, 7) Thrive, don't just survive- most congregations wanted to be a living congregation full of vibrance for the community, not just a surviving day to day church, and 8) most importantly each church has a real commitment to spiritual nurture themselves and develop their faith even deeper. (Taken from *Smaller Churches: Real Possibilities for Hard Times* by David Ray).

And this is exactly what we are working at doing with the Parish. Each church can find it's own niche and share that ministry with the other churches as well as the community. We are working with laity to build everyone up so that ministry can happen, even if we share people from the other churches to be able to accomplish our task. We are working at using our resources both monetary and gifts wisely as we collaborate where we can to keep building the Kingdom. And we are working towards thriving within our communities so that other people beyond our walls can see Jesus' love as we do.

And all of this is fueled by our own personal desire to grow in the Lord. We need to deepen our commitment to knowing God and develop our faith even deeper every day. Our recent discipleship series was well attended as we shared stories and ideas of how we can grow as God's disciples. We will be having other ways to grow as well. We may suggest a new book or two for people to grow within a specific area. We may be having other studies specific to a focus area. Maybe you have an idea as well, share it for everyone. One of my ideas is to have a movie night where the movie has Christian values that lead the people to make their decisions in life. And how can we learn and grow from their faithful witness.

Share your ideas with Pastor Wade or Pastor Ali as well! Together we can and are build(ing) strong communities for God!

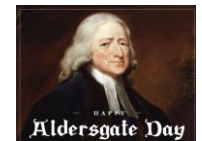

Shut-In Ministry One of our ministries that is behind within the Parish is our visitation to Shut-ins. And there are 2 specific reasons why. The first is, quite frankly, we don't know who all are shut-ins. One church has 2 different lists, one church goes by memory, and one church has different lists based on who you are talking to. We want to centralize all the lists to make it easier on the pastors but also so no one falls through the cracks and does not get a visit.

That leads to the second point, if a person is still in their home and not at a facility, under elder law, the pastor must have someone else not related to him/her accompany him/her on the visit. We do not have many people currently signed up to do this important task.

So we are asking for your help in two ways: 1) If you are/or know a person that is shut-in, please contact the Girard office at 814-774-3069. You may call any-time and leave a message if no one is there. Or you may email the information to girardumc@verizon.net. Please leave your name, the name of the shut-in, their address, phone number, and which church they belong to as well. 2) If you would like to help visit with Pastor Ali, please call the above number or email and let us know this as well.

We will then get a team together, work on scheduling visits, and Pastor will bring communion as well on the visit. Hope to see all the shut-ins soon.

We would like to invite the churches in the West COunty Parish to join together for a collection of items for the buckets. Items will be collected in April and May and will be delivered to Annual Conference in June. Collected items can be delivered to Fairview UMC or you can call Dottie Super at 814-490-1596 for pick up. you can fill a bucket on your own, or select items from the list and add them to a bucket at your church. Together we can make a difference. We know this is true because last summer family members in Indiana County received flood buckets to help with their clean up. **HELP FILL A BUCKET!!!**

One five-gallon round bucket with re-sealable lid (14.35" h x 12.19" w x 12.19" d)
No screw lids
May be used, but must be free from all residual product
Advertisements on the outside acceptable
One 32-64 oz. bottle liquid laundry detergent
One 16-40 oz. bottle liquid concentrate household cleaner
No spray cleaners
One 16-34 oz. bottle dish soap
One 4-8 oz. pump spray air freshener (liquid, not gel)
One 6-14 oz. pump spray insect repellent (pack of 10-20 wipes also acceptable)
Pump spray bottles must have protective covers
One scrub brush, with or without handle
18 re-useable cleaning wipes, no terrycloth, microfiber or paper towels, remove from packaging
Five scouring pads, no stainless-steel pads with soap in them, remove from packaging
36-50 clothespins
One 50-100 ft. clothesline (cotton or plastic line)
24 roll of heavy-duty trash bags (33-45-gallon sizes) remove from packaging
Five N95 particulate respirator dust masks (1-3 mm thickness) no surgical masks
Two pairs kitchen gloves, durable for multiple uses, remove from packaging
One pair work gloves, cotton with leather palm or all leather

Assembly Directions

- Place all liquid items on the bottom of the bucket.
- Place remaining items in the bucket fitting them around and between the liquid items.
- Scouring pads and trash bags can be separated in order to fit all items in the bucket.
- Clothespins may also be placed in a small re-sealable bag.
- Secure the lid on the filled bucket.
